- Meeting was called to order by Margaret Levi, she welcomed our newest member Brittany Adams. Brittany is representing the Convention and Visitors Bureau.
- The minutes from July were approved
- **Maintenance:** 2 trees were planted at Weisiger. The Clarks Run Trail has been paved. Allen Company has an Excavator and will be hired to clean out the "Reno" sinkhole.
- **Tree Committee:** Arbor Day plans are underway. Preston Miles is our liaison at Centre College. Centre is a Tree Campus.
- **Flower subcommittee:** the Bee and Butterfly garden will have trees and boulders in by this fall. We still have 30 bushes to go in. Bunny Davis center lost their petunias this year, the Hustonville Road bed is failing due to lack of irrigation.
- **Heart of Danville Update:** The mission for 2016-2017 is to survey all merchants as to their priorities; new signage directing people to sight around town will be one step.
- **Other Business:** The Mayor challenged the committee to come up with a solution to the problems with the Ginkgo trees on Main Street and the problems with the sidewalks. A motion was passed stating that: We will use the streetscape process as decided by the streetscape committee, using the 2007 plan as a starting point.

A second motion was passed authorizing Jane Brantley to go to Fiscal Court and work with the county regarding the flower bed at the Fourth St. entrance to the Court House. The next meeting would fall on Labor Day so it is rescheduled for September 6, at 4 pm
