APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Jack Hendricks made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 15, 2022, Meeting. The motion was seconded by Roger Hartner and the board unanimously approved.

APPEAL OF CITATION #P42106

James Coffey come before the board to appeal a parking ticket he received for parking in the 3rd St. Parking Lot. Mr. Coffey stated that he didn't really consider that he was illegally parking. He stated that he had a business here several years before moving to Stanford and he still comes to Danville about 3 times a week to patronage our downtown restaurants for lunch. He stated that his business is built around customer service. With the construction and parking constraints downtown, he thought that he would park there since that lot is never more than half full. Anthony Gray explained to him we have made concessions for the street scape project and tries to work with everyone as much as we can. Bridgette Lester also mentions there is free 2-hour parking in the parking garage. James Coffey thanked her for letting him know that but would like them to consider how it affects downtown businesses. And the board also replied that they have had a meeting with downtown businesses and advised him of the city has grant's available for businesses impacted. Mr. Coffey also mentioned it took 90 days for him to get a refund back on tax returns he had filed with the city and county so the board can understand his mindset with the city right now.

Roger Hartner made a motion to uphold the citation. The motion was seconded by Jack Hendricks and the board unanimously approved.

Tiffany Luttrell stated this citation had been brought to the board before and it was requested that we try to locate the owner. Officer Wesley spent quite some time on this citation, the registration information

received from the clerk's office show's John Slone is the owner. Mr. Slone stated that he sold the vehicle, but has never contacted us back with any information on who bought the vehicle. The citation is now up to be turned over to collections, so we are asking the board on how to proceed. Tiffany Luttrell explained the collection procedures.
