

MUNICIPAL ORDER NO. 08-10-01-2020

A MUNICIPAL ORDER TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING THE ENFORCEMENT OF CITY OF DANVILLE ORDINANCE SECTION 2.5-163(b) FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS TO ASSIST RESTAURANTS WITH SIDEWALK CAFÉ PERMITS DURING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARED TO COMBAT THE CORONAVIRUS EPIDEMIC.

WHEREAS, KRS 83A.060(12) and (13) authorize a legislative body to adopt municipal orders for matters relating to internal operations and functions of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, City of Danville Ordinance Section 2.5-163 pertains to conditions for businesses with an alcohol license and sidewalk café permits to adhere to, including a regulation that “no tables, chairs or any other furnishings, except plant tubs, shall be placed in the area used for the sidewalk café during any period when the sidewalk café is not open and being operated”; and

WHEREAS, City of Danville Ordinance Section 14-2 provides that “merchants may obstruct the sidewalks only so long as may be necessary in going out or receiving goods, wares, or merchandise or for sale of goods provided the pedestrian traffic shall not be substantially impeded”; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desire to assist businesses dealing with reduced capacities during the declared state of emergency and encourage more sidewalk seating by temporarily suspending the requirement that tables and chairs must be removed from the sidewalk when the business is closed;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADOPTED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Danville, Kentucky, as follows:

Section 2.5-163(b) requiring businesses with an alcohol license and sidewalk café permits to remove tables, chairs or any other furnishings from the sidewalk when the business is closed, shall be temporarily suspended for a period of six (6) months. To the extent that any provisions of previous municipal orders are inconsistent with this municipal order, then this municipal order shall

supersede all prior, inconsistent provisions. This Order shall automatically expire on February 10, 2021, unless renewed.
